**Please review this application or contact OMU to learn our program details and the available incentive.**

Select your insulation materials based on the recommendations shown in this application, contact local contractors, pick up a copy of the Iowa Energy Center's "Home Tightening, Insulation and Ventilation" booklet at OMU or download a copy from [www.iowaenergycenter.org/learning-institute/homeowners](http://www.iowaenergycenter.org/learning-institute/homeowners). Then follow these simple instructions to apply for your OMU Insulation Incentive:

1. Insulation materials must be installed in a home where the primary heating fuel is supplied by OMU.
2. After the insulation materials are installed, complete this application, including signatures.
3. Attach a sales receipt from the dealer and/or installer of the insulation materials showing total material and installation cost. Material must be purchased and installed between January 1 and December 31 to qualify for the eco@home OMU Residential Insulation Incentive Program. Applications will be accepted until January 31 for the prior year.
4. If insulation is self-installed, attach a copy of your energy audit, completed prior to insulation installation, advising additional insulation. OMU does offer free weatherization audits that can satisfy this requirement.

Note: Reflective Attic Barriers or "Blankets" are not recommended for colder climates because of the potential for moisture issues. OMU will not incentivize this type of project.

Please allow 6-8 weeks for payment. Payment processing may take longer if information is missing on the application. The Insulation Incentive is in the form of a credit to the customer's utility account.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- Please contact OMU with questions regarding this Residential Insulation Incentive Program.
- Residential customers who purchase their primary heating fuel from OMU are eligible to participate in the Residential Incentive Program.
- Insulation must be installed by a qualified installer unless an energy audit of the home has identified the need for added insulation. Attach a copy of the energy audit if the project is self-installed. OMU does offer free weatherization audits that can satisfy this requirement. Contact OMU to schedule a weatherization audit appointment prior to any insulation improvements you plan to include in this application.
- Only single family homes or multifamily buildings of four units or less are eligible.
- Homes built after December 31, 2000 are not eligible.
- Program excludes new residential construction: additions, garages, sheds, and workshops.
- Reflective Attic Barriers or “Blankets” are not recommended for colder climates because of the potential for moisture issues. OMU will not incentivize this type of project.

**INCENTIVE LIMIT:**

- Eligible customer’s total insulation incentive will not exceed 70 percent of the project cost, including installation, up to \$750.
- Customers are eligible for one (1) insulation incentive per program calendar year.

**PROGRAM TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- OMU does not guarantee that the installation and operation of energy efficiency equipment will result in reduced usage or demand or in cost savings. OMU makes no warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. - The incentives are offered on a first come, first served basis. OMU reserves the right to cancel or change these programs at any time. - **Insulation incentive payment will be in the form of a credit to the customer’s utility account.**
